A growth industry

Roads and other Infrastructure projects in Australia are in a growth phase over the next 25 years. The safety of construction workers is an essential part of those projects creating a high demand for qualified persons in height related operational roles

All workers who conduct or supervise tasks whilst at height will find this course beneficial to workplace safety. This course will enable you to comply with current WHS legislation.

Who can enrol in this qualification

- Be at least 15 years old
- Have basic levels of language, literacy and numeracy skills
- Be physically fit enough to move light equipment in a single person lift perform construction duties.

Suitability Requirements

A Pre-training review is conducted prior to enrolment in order to determine if the program and industry is appropriate and required language, literacy, numeracy and oral communication skills.
