

HLTAID009 Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation

Be prepared before you need it!

This CPR course will provide you with the knowledge, skills and confidence to enable you to sustain life and minimise the consequences of injury and illness until professional help arrives.

Who can enrol in this qualification

All persons - minimum 14 years of age, who may be required to provide a response in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings. Most workplaces require at least 1 person to hold a current CPR Certification.

Suitability Requirements

A Pre-training review is conducted prior to enrolment to determine if the program is appropriate along with the required language, literacy, numeracy and oral communication skills. Participants must be able to bend and kneel on the floor to perform CPR for at least 2 minutes. No prior knowledge or pre-requites required.

Assessment

Assessment is conducted by the below methods:

Including at least 2 minutes of uninterrupted single rescuer cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) (5 cycles of both compressions and ventilations) on an adult & infant resuscitation manikin placed on the floor.
