Elevated Work Platforms are a safe and reliable means of reaching areas that are otherwise be inaccessible. However, working at heights and on a mobile platform always carry a number of risks and hazards. That's why it is important that everyone who uses an EWP is fully trained and competent.

Who can enrol in this qualification

Suitability Requirements

A Pre-training review is conducted prior to enrolment as it is essential that students must be able to read write and speak English to successfully complete this training and licence. All persons MUST be a minimum 16 years of age.
